Received an Order for an Energy-from-Waste Plant in U.K.

Hitachi Zosen Inova AG (hereafter "HZI", Switzerland), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hitachi Zosen Corporation, that designs, constructs, and maintains energy-from-waste ("EfW") plants, has received an order from Indaver NV (Belgium) that is engaged in waste treatment throughout Europe.

The project is the construction of a new EfW plant in Essex, UK. It is scheduled to complete the construction and start commercial operation in 2026. The facility will process 595,000 tons of general waste annually.



Our Group has delivered approximately 1,000 waste treatment plants in Japan and overseas. This is our 18th order received in UK and Ireland, which are key markets for our Group. Through sanitary waste treatment and clean energy technology, our Group will contribute to the achievement of the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) adopted at the United Nations Summit and realizing a sound material-cycle society.
